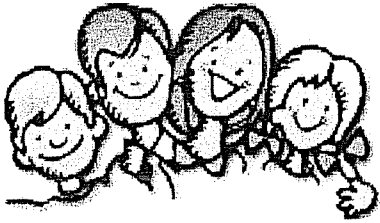
Información de la Cerradura de Escuelas por el Clima de Invierno

Attendance Guidelines

The staff at Guy Lee is very committed to our students' academic success. Regular attendance is critical to every child's learning. We monitor every child's attendance and tardies on a regular basis. Below you will find information from the State of Oregon Statutes on school attendance and Guy Lee's policy on attendance/tardies.

Duty to send children to school

ORS 339.020 –

“every person having control of any child between the ages of 7 and 18 years who has not completed the 12th grade is required to send such child to and maintain such child in regular attendance at a public full-time school during the entire school term.”

Definition of Irregular Attendance

ORS 339.065 –

“eight unexcused one-half day absences in any four week period during which the school is in session shall be considered irregular attendance. An absence may be excused by a principal or teacher if the absence is caused by the pupil's sickness, by the sickness of some member of the family or by an emergency. A principal or teacher may also excuse absences for the other reasons where satisfactory arrangements are made in advance of the absence.”

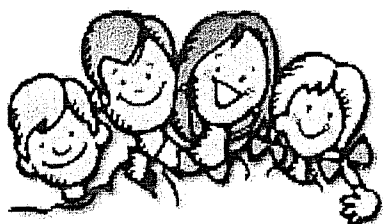
Guy Lee's Policy on Attendance/Tardies

- Please call the school by 9:00 am or send a note the following day explaining the absence.
- If you do not call in when your child is sick, it will be recorded as unexcused.
- Being tardy to school may be counted as ½ day unexcused absence.
- Checking out of school before the school day ends may be counted as ½ day absence.
- In cases of excessive absences, a medical excuse from a physician or dentist may be requested to excuse the absence.

Pautas de Asistencia

El personal de Guy Lee esta muy comprometido al éxito académico de nuestros alumnos. La asistencia regular es muy critica para el aprendizaje de cada alumno. Seguimos de cerca tanto la asistencia como las veces que llega tarde cada alumno. Abajo encontraran la información del estado de Oregon sobre los estatutos de la asistencia a la escuela y las pautas de Guy Lee en cuanto a las faltas/llegar tarde.

El deber de mandar niños a la escuela

ORS 339.020 –

“toda persona que tenga control de cualquier niño entre las edades de 7 y 18 años que no ha completado el 12 grado se exige que mande a tal niño y que lo mantenga en asistencia regular en una escuela publica de tiempo completo durante el periodo entero de escuela.”

Definición de Asistencia Irregular

ORS 339.065 –

“ausencias de ocho días parciales en cualquier periodo de cuatro semanas durante el cual la escuela este en sesión se considerara asistencia irregular. Una ausencia se puede excusar de parte de un director o un maestro si la ausencia del alumno es causada por su propia enfermedad, la enfermedad de un familiar o por una emergencia. Un director o maestro también puede excusar ausencias por otras razones donde se hayan hecho arreglos satisfactorios por adelantado de la ausencia.”

Pautas de Guy Lee de Asistencia/Llegar tarde

- Por favor llamen a la escuela antes de las 9:00 a.m. o manden una nota el día siguiente explicando la ausencia.
- Si no llaman cuando su niño esta enfermo, se registrará como no excusado.
- El llegar tarde a la escuela se puede contar como un medio día no excusado.
- El irse de la escuela antes de que se acabe el día escolar puede ser contado como un medio día no excusado.
- En casos de ausencias en exceso, una excusa de un doctor o dentista se puede pedir para excusar las ausencias.

2012-2013 SPS STUDENT TRANSFER INFORMATION

ELEMENTARY, MIDDLE & HIGH SCHOOL IN-DISTRICT TRANSFER REQUESTS

In-District (Intra-District) Transfer requests are for students residing within Springfield School District attendance boundaries that wish to attend another school within Springfield.

The Springfield School District will be accepting student transfer requests for the 2012-13 school year **beginning** the first school day of January 2012 through the last school day of January 2012. A lottery draw of requests submitted in January will be done after the last school day in January to determine where requests are placed on the waiting list. Requests submitted after the last school day in January will be placed on the waiting list in the order they are received. Requests submitted the same day are placed according to lottery draw.

Transfer forms are available at any school building, online (www.sps.lane.edu) or from the Instruction Office at 525 Mill Street.

Once the transfer has been approved, your student will be able to remain at the school you have chosen until they complete the highest grade at that level. You must submit a transfer for new students entering kindergarten or for students not currently on an approved transfer.

Students must reapply when changing school levels (i.e., from elementary to mid school; or mid to high school).

A student's "resident" school is the attendance boundary where the student's family lives. Daycare providers are not considered the student's residence. Students may not use a relative or friend's address to gain access to a school. Families are required to provide valid proof of residency upon enrollment.

APPROVAL PROCESS

ELEMENTARY & MIDDLE SCHOOL

Transfer requests for elementary and middle schools submitted during January 2012 will be approved based upon the available capacity at each school. Transfers will be processed in the order in which they are received. Transfers received on the same day will be assigned a number according to a lottery draw.

Transfer requests submitted in January 2012 that are not approved due to lack of space, or requests turned in after the last school day of January 2012 will be considered on a one-for-one trade until the beginning of the 2012-13 school year. It is important to realize that approved transfers will require parents to provide transportation to and from school.

Each request is considered on a case-by-case basis regardless of the number of children in the family. Where possible the district will attempt to keep whole families in the same school. Families are required to provide valid proof of residency upon enrollment.

HIGH SCHOOL

High school transfer requests submitted during January for the coming school year will be determined through one-for-one exchanges only. Schools that are nearing capacity will engage principals in student information review (i.e., student transcript, behavior and attendance history, siblings), which may include an interview with the parent(s) and/or student, prior to determining the transfer status. Hardship cases will be given priority.

It is important to realize that approved transfers will require parents to provide transportation to and from school.

Each request is considered on a case-by-case basis regardless of the number of children in the family. Where possible the district will attempt to keep whole families in the same school. Families are required to provide valid proof of residency upon enrollment.

OUT-OF-DISTRICT (INTER-DISTRICT) TRANSFER REQUESTS

Local school districts are in the process of determining the process for transferring students between districts (open enrollment, HB 3681). Therefore, at this time, the following guidelines apply for students wishing to attend a school outside their resident district.

Out of District (Inter-District) transfer requests are for students residing outside Springfield School District boundaries (i.e., Bethel, Creswell, Crow, Eugene, Fern Ridge, Junction City, Lowell, Marcola, McKenzie, Pleasant Hill, South Lane) wishing to attend a school within Springfield boundaries.

Out of district (Inter-district) residents, even those currently on an approved transfer, must apply *each year* to attend a Springfield school.

The Instruction Office at 525 Mill Street, Springfield, will begin taking Out-of-District transfer applications **beginning** the first school day in January 2012 through the last school day of January 2012 for the coming year.

A lottery drawing will occur after the last school day in January 2012. Students who attended Springfield schools during the previous school year and are requesting to return to a Springfield school for the next school year will be given priority over current waiting list students and new applicants. Returning seniors will receive top priority.

Applications received after the last school day in January 2012 will be assigned to the waiting list in the order they are received. Requests submitted on the same day are placed on the waiting list by lottery draw.

Out-of-District transfers are permitted on a one-for-one student exchange ONLY between the transferring student's resident district and the Springfield School District.

Parents should also contact their resident district to ensure compliance with their transfer process.
