LUNCH MENU UPDATE

We have received feedback a few times this year about how the district lunch menu does not always agree with what we actually serve. This inconsistency can create problems when you send your child to school with a plan that she eats her favorite hot lunch... but it turns out they are serving something she doesn't like.

The *reason* this sometimes happens is that we are a small school, and the food delivery service brings food in bulk. We therefore have a surplus of food that builds up over time. Our Cafeteria Manager, Michelle, makes responsible decisions and deviates from the district menu so that she uses up the surplus of food that is causing our kitchen storage to overflow.

The *problem* is that we need to communicate those changes to parents. The *solution* is that Michelle will begin emailing parents about the menu each week so that you have accurate information about the Walterville lunch menu. This email will go to all families who shared an accurate email address on their enrollment form.
