Mr. Walterville Pageant

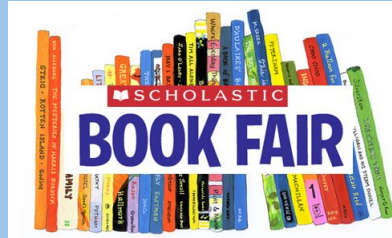
